

CALL for PAPERS

The New York State Engineering Technology Association would like to invite you to share your professional expertise in your content area. Whether you are an exhibitor who wants to submit an invited paper/presentation or a faculty or graduate student who wants to have your work peer reviewed by content experts and considered for publication on our web site, you are welcome to submit your work. Your publication, if accepted, connects your paper with our vast community of students, faculty, administrators and vendors who specialize or who are interested in your specific field of study. Presentations and publications will be reviewed in advance for faculty who will be seeking credit towards their institution's scholarship requirements.

Topics can be in the technology areas of electrical, electronic, mechanical, manufacturing, civil, architecture, computer networking, computer systems design and operation, computer and network security, teaching and learning of technology and related areas. Material must be original, scientifically accurate, and in good form editorially. The paper should be informative, summarizing the basic facts and conclusions, and maintaining a coherence and unity of thought. Contributions may include research papers, case studies, tutorials, course or courseware experiences, evaluations, review papers, and viewpoints.

All presentations will be at the most 50 minutes, including Q & A at the end of the presentation.

Formal Papers

Formal Papers should be submitted in Association for Computing Machinery (ACM) or American Psychological Association (APA) format. Papers should be no longer than eight pages in length not including a title page. Formal 200 word abstract submissions must be submitted via email to NYSETAPAPERS@alfredstate.edu no later than June 1, 2013. Formal paper must be submitted by September 1, 2013. Papers will be refereed and, if accepted, will be published via the Web for a minimum of three years.

Presentations and Invited Papers

Papers or Presentations in an invited session should present a cohesive and comprehensive focus on a topic relevant to the interest groups, categories or products described by this conference. Contributions in invited session proposals or presentations can be extended abstracts of approximately two to five pages or a power point presentation showing the principal contribution of the paper or presentation so as to allow for an informed peer review. These will be presented as scheduled during one of the interest group sessions. Papers or presentations must be submitted via email to NYSETAPAPERS@alfredstate.edu no later than September 1, 2013.

Poster Sessions

Design a poster to share the main points of your teaching, research, results or program related to your interest group. Poster presentations provide the opportunity for you to both expand your audience and interact individually with interested viewers. You must bring your own display boards and mounting structures, laptop and extension cords as needed. We will provide tables and power outlets. Posters will be presented simultaneously during the 11-4:00 time block as indicated on the program schedule for each interest group session. This is indicated as "Lunch, Exhibitors and Poster Sessions" on the schedule of events. During the poster presentation session, attendees will freely move between presentations to view

your work and talk with you 1:1 about your findings. Poster summary or abstracts must be submitted via email to NYSETAPAPERS@alfredstate.edu no later than September 1, 2013.

How to submit

All presentations and invited papers should be submitted in electronic format, as a single file. The requested format for electronic submission is PDF, doc, or docx format for the invited papers and ppt or pptx for the invited presentations. Both papers and presentations should be submitted on-line by emailing it to: NYSETAPAPERS@alfredstate.edu.
